Five outward bound coasters and three whale ships, lying off and on, were in sight from Waikiki last evening.

The weather between these islands during the past week has been very calm, the *Sappho* was four days making the passage from Hilo.

The whaling bark *George and Susan* arrived yesterday from New Bedford. She is five and a half months out. Reports having seen whales only once during the voyage.

The water flowed from the Artesian Well, in the lot next the Government Building, yesterday afternoon, at 3:30. The well was then about 493 feet deep. Sandy soil was still being bored through. The boring will be continued until the hard rock is reached, which is expected to be found a few feet deeper.
