A Wonderful Bug.

Mrs. HARDACRE describes a jeweled bug, about an inch long, belonging to a Washington lady: "It is richly enameled on the upper side in dark-blue. Its wings are crusted with diamonds, its eyes are gems, and the slender feelers are delicate threads of light. In this form it is worn as a pendant to an Etruscan necklace. On the under side it is of soft beaten gold, with its legs neatly doubled up and crossed, and can be worn, this side up, on a chataleine as a scent-bottle, which shape it much resembles.
