

Official Programme:

1st KAMEHAMEHA PLATE: RUNNING RACE. 1 1/2 mile dash Free for all.

2nd HIS MAJESTY'S CUP: RUNNING RACE. 1 mile dash Hawaiian bred horses.

3rd KING'S PLATE: TROTTING and PACING. Mile heats; best 2 in 3 to harness. Hawaiian bred horses.

4th QUEEN'S PLATE: RUNNING RACE. 3/4 mile dash Free for all.

5th GOVERNOR DOMINIS' CUP: RUNNING RACE. 3/4 mile dash Hawaiian bred horses.

6th WAIMANALO CUP: TROTTING RACE. Three minute class; mile heat; best 2 in 3. For all horses that have never beaten 3 minutes.

7th FUTURITY STAKES: RUNNING RACE. Sweepstakes of \$200 3/4 mile dash For Hawaiian bred 2 year olds 19 entries till and over 1-8-89.

8th KAPIOLANI PARK PLATE: TROTTING and PACING. Free for all. Mile heats; best 3 in 5. All horses with record of 2:00 or better to be handicapped.

9th ROSITA CHALLENGE CUP: RUNNING RACE. 1 mile dash. Free for all, winner to beat 1:45 1/2. To be run for annually.

10th HAWAIIA HOTEL STABLES' CUP, and \$500 added: RUNNING RACE. 3/4 mile heats; best 2 in 3. Hawaiian bred horses. Cup to become the property of the winner two consecutive years. Winner last year, Waterford Colt.

11th POST MATCH, \$20: TROTTING and PACING. Mile heats; best 2 in 3. For all horses not having a record of 2:00 or better. To be driven by members of the Hawaiian Jockey Club to road cart.

12th WATERFORD CUP: RUNNING RACE. 1 1/4 mile dash. Hawaiian bred horses.

13th OCEANIC STEAMSHIP CO. CUP: NOVELTY RACE RUNNING. 1 mile dash. 1st quarter, 2nd quarter, 3rd quarter and 4th quarter. Hawaiian bred horses.

14th PU'NY RACE: RUNNING. 1 mile dash. For all ponies 14 hands and under. Hawaiian bred.

Whale Boats.

In answer to several enquiries concerning Whale Boat Frames, we have now in course of construction, 3 Whale Boat Frames 74 feet by 32 feet long. These frames are bent in one piece of oak, and held to shape, thus requiring little fact to set them up and build. The full frame for such boats, including canis, 45 sections in number, is sold at \$28; with large stems on keel, and ready to plan \$40. They are not intended to be clinker built, nor as the frail imported whale boats proper, but are intended for rough use and durability, yet light weight, for fishing and trading purposes. We have exported these frames and intend doing so, and make this offer to amateurs and other desirous of trying their hand, with plenty of leisure and small cash to make a business.
