### NAVAL NOTES.

Movements of Uncle Sam's Marine Dogs of War.

The Concord has arrived at Chin Kiang. The Petrel has sailed from Chefoo for New Chang; the Chicago, from Lisbon for Tangier. The Montgomery has arrived at New York. The Baltimore has also arrived at Chefoo.

The new cruiser Olympia, which is now being finished up, will be ready to go into commission about the 1st of the new year, and preparations are being made to secure a crew to man her. It is now necessary to put some ship out of commission to get enough men to man the Olympia. It is likely the Chicago will be the one. In the annual report of the Bureau of Navigation attention is called to the necessity of legislation to permit more men to be enlisted. Secretary Herbert also made a report concerning this matter, and recommended that the present law should be amended so that the Navy could enlist at least 2000 more men.

The Adams and Miantonomah are to be placed out of commission. The Swatara is to be turned over to the Naval Reserve of California for a practice ship.

Naval officers are making an effort to have the San Francisco kept at home. Secretary Herbert desired to send her to the European station.

**RAMIE CULTURE.**

A New Machine Which Will Revolutionize the Industry.

"I have just seen a new machine which will enable the ramie industry to revolutionize the world," said T. J. Meacham, who is connected with a large Eastern patent firm, at the Palace yesterday. "I have just come up from Bradford, where a man named Felix Frennery has constructed a machine known as a 'decoricator' for extracting the fiber from the ramie plant. It has been found to work with perfect success, and with two men and a boy can do the work of 1500 Chinese. I am confident that the machine will be the means of making ramie culture one of the biggest industries in California. Thus far it has been impossible to raise ramie in California at a profit, though there are thousands upon thousands of acres of irrigated land in the State where excellent fiber can be grown. The trouble has been that farmers in this country cannot compete with the product of cheap Chinese and Japanese labor. The new machine will reduce the cost of labor to a minimum, and will undoubtedly give the industry a boom in California." S. F. Chronicle.
