NAVAL NOTES.

Recruiting of Crews—Condition of Bennington.

There is a busy time aboard the receiving ship Independence at Mare Island. Lieutenant Clark, recruiting officer, is enlisting men to make up crews for the Boston and Marion, now lying ready for sea at this yard. A draft of twenty-five seamen, ordinary seamen and firemen is also being made for Monocacy, now in Chinese waters. Many men are offering themselves.

The Albatross will soon be ready for the water again, Constructor Snow having about completed the re-enforcing of her midship plates.

A dispatch was received on the 9th inst. to the effect that the United States cruiser Bennington had left Acapulco for San Francisco for repairs. The steamer City of Sydney, which arrived from Central America recently, brought a confirmation of the report that the Bennington's boilers had given out, as the result of careless work at Mare Island, but even then the authorities at Washington and those in charge at the navy yard insisted that the Bennington's boilers were all right. The fact that the cruiser is returning for repairs, however, indicates that the original report was correct.

OVER A MILLION FRANCS.

The Amount San Domingo Will Have to Pay to France.

PARIS, March 9.—The terms of the settlement of the difficulty between San Domingo and France provide for the payment of 1,000,000 francs for the illegal detention of Captain Boimere and 20,000 francs for the murder of Caville, a French naval officer. Naval honors will be paid to the murdered man by the French and Italian Ministers. The remaining question in dispute, which is of minor importance, will be settled through the Spanish Minister, who is acting as arbitrator.
