ELECTRIC RAILWAY BILL.

Mr. Neumann Says a Part is Un-constitutional.

There was not a large attendance of citizens at the open meeting of the House judiciary committee on the electric railway bill last night. Mr. Neumann, attorney for the Hawaiian Tramways Company, was there to watch the interests of that corporation, together with its manager, Mr. Pain. C. G. Ballentyne and J. B. Castle represented the applicants for the franchise. W. E. Rowell, Superintendent of Public Works, looked on with Government eyes.

F. Godfrey as clerk of committee read the bill through. Mr. Neumann made comments here and there, suggesting where not only his client's but the public's rights seemed to be infringed. His most important objection was where the bill gives the proposed corporation the right of eminent domain, which he held clearly unconstitutional.

At the conclusion of the reading the chairman, Mr. Robertson, asked if anyone present desired to ask questions or offer remarks. There being no response, he adjourned the meeting.
