FROM OVER THE WAVES.

THE WAIALEALE AND MOKOLOI BRING LIVE STOCK.

Harks Rithet and Albert Loading Sugar--Movements of Vessels Along the Wharves.

The bark S C Allen is at Nuuanu street wharf.

The bark Rithet is taking on sugar at Kinau wharf.

The schooner Robert Lewers is unloading at Brewer's.

The bark Albert is loading Hackfeld sugar at Oceanic wharf.

The schooner Kawilani brought a load of paddy in from Kasia today.

The steamer Mokoli arrived in this morning with a deck load of live stock.

The bark Mauna Ala is discharging her cargo of coal at the railway bunkers.

The steamer J A Cummins will resume her trips to Waimanalo next Monday.

The steamer Keolu is loading 150 tons of coal for Makaweli plantation at the railway wharf.

The steamer Kilauoa Hou is coaling at Nuuanu street wharf and will go to Hamakua next week with a load of fertilizers.

The steamer Kaula came off the marine railway this morning, and the steamer Waimanalo took that berth for a general overhauling.

According to private advices from the Arctic ocean the whaling catch of 1894 has been exceptionally small. Some of the whalers had no luck whatever, while none had better than four of a catch.

The steamer Waialeale brought in sugar from Lahaina and Kukuluaele plantations and 26 head of cattle from Cornwall's ranch this morning. She reports plenty of rain on the Hamakua coast.

There is no foundation to the rumor that the Holt Company is to put on a line of steamers between England, the Orient and Vancouver, B. C.

A letter to R P Rithet & Co, received through the arrival of the Northern Pacific liner Strathnevis, states that the sealing schooner Saddle Turpel left Hakodate for the Copper Islands on June 9, and that the Umbria followed the next day.
