BOARD OF HEALTH.

The Rio Janeiro's Freight May be Brought Back.

The Board of Health held a special meeting yesterday afternoon to take action on the matter of the return of the Rio Janeiro's freight for this port. A letter from the San Francisco agents of the Pacific Mail Company to H. Hackfeld & Co. was read and President Smith said he could see no reason why the freight should not be allowed to land. As foretold in yesterday's BULLETIN a motion was passed that the Rio's freight be allowed to return to this port, if it be accompanied by a certificate of fumigation and the mode of fumigation used.

G. W. R. King was appointed an agent of the Board of Health.

The question of raising the embargo on evening meetings was discussed, but it was decided to continue the present regulations in force for the present.

A request from several merchants to be allowed to ship tobacco and cigars was laid over.

It was ordered that the natives who have been using the Kuna-wai spring water be provided with water at the expense of the government.
