

AN UNDERGROUND CITY FOUND.

A Discovery Made by Russian Explorers in Asia.

The Russians have made a singular discovery in Central Asia. In Turkestan, on the right bank of the Amou Daria, is a chain of rocky hills near the Bokharan town of Karki, and a number of large caves which, upon examination, were found to lead to an underground city, built apparently long before the Christian era.

The underground Bokharan city is about two versts long, and is composed of an enormous labyrinth of corridors, streets and squares, surrounded by houses and other buildings two or three stories high. The edifices contain all kinds of domestic utensils, pots, urns, vases, etc. In some of the streets falls of earth and rock have obstructed the passages, but generally the visitor can walk about freely without so much as lowering his head.

The high degree of civilization attained by the inhabitants of the city is shown by the fact that they built in several stories, by the symmetry of the streets and squares, and by the beauty of the baked clay and metal utensils and of the ornaments and coins which have been found.—London Public Opinion.

Mexico's Greatest Temple.

The great temple in the City of Mexico was a stone structure of five stages or stories, 300 feet square at the base and 120 feet high. There were eight similar structures of almost similar size in the city, and nearly 2000 much smaller.

In the new British Parliament there are 131 graduates of Oxford, 110 of Cambridge, 24 of London, 31 of Scotch and 29 of Irish universities. Of the public schools Eton is first with 104 members, then comes Harrow with 51; Rugby has only 17. 
Professor Richey publishes some figures of mortality from diphtheria in the Revue Scientifique which seems to show that either the disease has this year taken a milder form or else Dr. Roux's serum treatment is effective. The deaths in 1887 in Paris hospitals were 1490; from 1887 to 1891 they were from 900 to 960 a year; from 1892 to 1894 they averaged 733; in 1895 they were 239.

Over 250 trees in the famous Orangerie of Versailles have perished during the last four years, including the Grand Bourbon, or "oranger du comteable," which dates from the sixteenth century, and the others are in bad condition. This is due, it is said, to their having been watered with a liquid containing injurious chemicals.

London's street names are a source of endless confusion. There are now 151 Church streets, 129 Union streets and 116 New streets. British loyalty is shown in 99 Queen, 95 King and 78 Prince's streets, while royal names are borne by 119 John, 109 George, 91 Charles, 83 William, 87 James and 57 Elizabeth streets.

The Los Angeles Council has passed a circus ordinance, so that hereafter all dollar shows will pay \$1000 for the first day of their visit, and \$800 for the second day, and 50-cent shows will be taxed \$500 for the first day and \$350 for the second day, and \$50 for all side shows.
