

A WAYWARD DERELICT.

Wonderful Voyages Made by a Modern Flying Dutchman at Sea

There are few examples where in the imagery of men's minds has in later years become realities. A marvelous instance is the case of the schooner Fannie E. Wolston.

The other extreme is now presented to us by the hydrographic office. A wooden three-masted schooner called the Fannie E. Wolston encountered a terrific hurricane, and, becoming water-logged, her crew took the boats and abandoned the vessel off Cape Hatteras October 15, 1891.

The vessel, storm-racked and abandoned by man, began the most remarkable voyage of which there is any record. For over three years she journeyed across the Atlantic ocean, surviving gale after gale in which many staunch vessels, manned by skillful men, went to the bottom.

After she was abandoned it is known that the Wolston was afloat for three years and six days. The distance which she traveled in that time can only be conjectured—that is, by locating the places at which she was reported as having been spoken, and connecting these with straight lines, and measuring these lines, which make the enormous total of 9,156 miles.
