One by Representative Allen of Nebraska, a Populist, among other things declares "that all islands in close proximity to the mainland of the United States of America should as speedily as possible, by treaties of purchase, be annexed to this Government, as essential to our safety in times of war and the convenience and necessity of our commerce in times of peace."
