A PARTY TO INSPECT THE WORK ABROAD.

Wealthy Contributors to Learn How Their Donations Are Employed.

NEW YORK, December 10.—A unique and interesting pilgrimage to both home and foreign missionary workers is soon to be made by representatives of a number of wealthy contributors to missionary work.

It is to enable these, and others interested in mission work, to know by actual observation exactly how the missionary conducts his labors, that the trip is to be made.

Then will begin the study of missions in Japan. The work of all American missions there will be looked into, after which China will be visited.

The Fiji, Tonga and Samoan groups will be visited, and the return will be made by way of Honolulu and a general tour of the Hawaiian Islands and New Zealand will be made.
