CHURCHILL ON POLYNESIA
 Talks on Samoans and Origin of Other Pacific Nations.
 Theory that Hawaii was Peopled from Samoa—Ancient Relics Exhibited—Hawaiian Historical Society.

More than a hundred people enjoyed the lecture of Hon. W. Churchill at the Y. M. C. A. yesterday evening on the subject of Samoa and the origin of Polynesian races. The speaker interested his audience for more than an hour. He talked in an easy, conversational way, reading at times from a portfolio.

Many of the speaker's deductions from Samoan folk lore differed from accounts supplied by Hawaiian ethnologists from Polynesian traditions. It was a surprise to many to learn that Samoa was the center from which the people of the Pacific sprang. Hawaiian traditions point farther south. In the papers of the Hawaiian Historical Society is evidence of migrations hither from Tahiti. Possibly there were different arrivals here from the south.
 Mr. Churchill displayed a Samoan "talking stick," also exhibited a war club with a clear tradition five hundred years back. He believed the club was older still and used, as its name indicated, at the battle of Matamama. This was a fight between natives of the island of Upolu with trespassers or invaders from other islands, whom the Upoluans called Tongans and managed to chase off to their canoes. The people thus repulsed went to various lands including Hawaii, Savaii, name of the largest island in the Samoan or Navigator's group, was suggested by the lecturer as having been the origin of the name "Hawaii."

Mr. Churchill gave the native account of the origin of the royal lines of Samoa, most of it silly as aboriginal Polynesian tradition usually is. Such matter is, however, of importance to the ethnologist from the points of similarity between traditions of different nations or tribes.

At the conclusion of the lecture, President W. R. Castle asked if there was any business to come before the society. W. F. Allen rose and proposed Mr. Churchill as a corresponding member, and the proposition being seconded by Jos. Emerson was carried unanimously. The president then announced the annual meeting next Monday evening, when it was hoped members and others would have the pleasure of hearing S. Percy Smith, Surveyor General of New Zealand, who is a corresponding member of the Hawaiian Historical Society.
