AFTERNOON PROCEEDINGS

Senate Refuses to Grant Land for Railroad Wharf Purposes.

Clothes Sprinkling Bill Carries on Second Reading—Minister Cooper Initiates a Marine Park Scheme.

In the Senate yesterday afternoon consideration of Senate Bill 15, to grant a strip of harbor front to the railroad company for wharf purposes, was resumed. After a further debate of an hour in which several members and Minister Cooper took part, the motion to pass second reading of the bill was defeated by a vote of 7 to 6, Senator Northrup not voting.

A motion to adopt the report of the committee and lay the bill on the table was then carried without further opposition.

House Bill 73, relating to the descent of property, was referred to the Judiciary Committee.

House Bill 80, laundering of clothing, passed second reading. Third reading set for May 10.

Several communications relating to the passage of various bills were received from the House, which took the usual course.

A communication from a committee of the Citizens' Guard in charge of the Carter Memorial Fountain, asking for a conference with joint committees of the Senate and House in regard to a suitable location, was read together with a message from the House concerning its action on the same, and on motion the Senate appointed its Public Lands Committee consisting of Senators Lyman, Baldwin and McCandless, to act for the Senate in the matter.

The conference report on House Bill 35, relating to claims against the estates of deceased persons, was adopted.

Minister Cooper gave notice of his intention to introduce a bill to regulate the opening of streets on private lands in the District of Honolulu, and also of a bill to establish a marine park on the east side of the harbor.

Senate Bill 40, relating to Chinese Immigration, was referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations.

A ten minutes secret executive session was then held after which, at 2:55 p. m., the Senate adjourned.
