

**DEWEY CONTROLS MANILA.**

Continued from Third Page.

to the World from Hong-  
 kong says: Final instruc-  
 tions to Admiral Dewey from  
 President McKinley regard-  
 ing the future of Manila were  
 received last night.

Washington, May 9.—Upon  
 General Merriam now rests  
 most of the work of prepar-  
 ing for the expedition to the  
 Philippines. Merriam is ex-  
 pected to have more than  
 5000 men in the expedition.

The Navy Department has  
 decided to curtail Construc-  
 tor Capp's expedition, now  
 that the full extent of the in-  
 jury to Dewey's ships is  
 known. Dewey has said  
 that he wants no coal, only  
 ammunition and food need  
 be sent.

New York, May 9.—The  
 Herald's Washington corres-  
 pondent telegraphs: All nec-  
 essary preparations were  
 made today in the War De-  
 partment to send an army,  
 consisting of both volunteers  
 and regulars, of over 81,000  
 men to invade Cuba.

The first detachment of  
 this army will be in Cuba  
 by Sunday next and will im-  
 mediately establish a base  
 of supplies for United States  
 troops.

The entire policy of the  
 administration has been  
 changed since the day the  
 news of Admiral Dewey's  
 great victory reached Wash-  
 ington. From a defensive  
 plan of operation the Govern-  
 ment has now taken a most  
 aggressive stand. In the  
 Cabinet meeting today final  
 arrangements were made  
 which it is hoped will cul-  
 minate in the capture by the  
 United States army and navy  
 of all the Spanish possessions.

Chicago, May 7. A special to  
 the News from Washington says:  
 Francis B. Randall, chief engineer  
 of the McCulloch, died May 1st.  
 It is understood that he was not  
 hurt in the battle, but died before.  
 San Francisco, May 10.—The  
 steamship City of Peking arrived in  
 port yesterday evening and by next  
 Saturday, it is thought, can be  
 ready to start for Manila with re-en-  
 forcements in the way of troops,  
 ammunition and coal for Admiral  
 Dewey's squadron.

Berlin, May 7.—Emperor William  
 is in secret sympathy with the  
 United States. He receives private  
 reports of the war.

New York, May 7.—The Sun's  
 London correspondent speaks of an  
 "exceedingly threatening phase  
 which the West African quarrel be-  
 tween Great Britain and France has  
 now assumed."

There is fear of famine at Porto  
 Rico.




