WATER FOR SUBURBAN LOTS

An Old Crater Will Be Used for Reservoir.

Pumping Plant With Capacity of 3,000,000 Gallons Per Day Will Be Put In.

For a long time the question of a water supply has been in the minds of those people who have purchased lots on the slopes of Diamond Head within the past two years. It is well known that during that time nearly a thousand lots have been sold to various people by W. C. Aebi, F.L. Dortch and A. V. Gear. Of course it was expected that water would come from some source but there was by no means anything definite. The lots were found to be fine and the atmosphere the best possible about Honolulu, but the perplexing question of water was on the lips of all the owners of land out there.

The trouble is now at an end. Recently a large portion of the Pahoa land was bought of Paul R. Isenberg by Gear, Lansing & Co. and again the question of water came in.

Anyone who has been out to Pahoa in the vicinity of Telegraph Hill has seen a large bowl-like depression that would seem to have been at one time an auxiliary crater.

It has been decided by the company that purchased the tract mentioned, to put in at Pahoa, or more correctly, Kaimuki, a pumping plant with a capacity of 3,000,000 gallons per day. Two twelve inch wells will be sunk and the crater mentioned will be properly arranged and used as a reservoir.

At the giving out of this news there should be joy in many places. What with the electric cars and a modern pumping plant and reservoir of great capacity, future residents of the Diamond Head slopes need worry no longer.
