ITEMS FROM HARBOR FRONT

The Kaui sails for Lahaina on a special trip this afternoon.

The Spokane arrived in Hilo October 3, 23 days from Port Townsend.

The John G North arrived in Honolulu October 6, 18 days from San Francisco.

The brig Consuelo arrived in Mahukona, October 6, 15 days from San Francisco.

The Nosaou could not get away for Kauai ports this afternoon. She will sail at 4 p m today.

The mail wagon backed into a soda water Chinaman's cart on the Inter-Island wharf this morning. One wheel was dished. The whole fault lay with the Chinaman.

The schooner Waihua went on the marine railway Saturday to be examined after touching while going out the channel the other day. There were no damages.

The schooner Concord went ashore about half way up the channel Sunday afternoon and not where the Miowera grounded, as stated in another paper. She was gotten off by the tug boat.

The Hawaiian bark R P Ribbet, Thompson master, arrived in port on Sunday, 12 days from San Francisco with a cargo of 2000 tons of general merchandise, 29 horses, 254 hogs and 9 cows consigned to C Brewer & Co.

DORIC FROM THE ORIENT.

Items of News Gathered Aboard the Ship.

The O. & O. S. S. Doric, Smith commander, was telephoned off Waianae shortly after 8 o'clock Monday morning but it was about 1 p. m. when she hauled alongside the Pacific Mail wharf, her delay outside being caused by the large number (nearly 700 all told) of Japanese and Chinese immigrants for this port it was necessary for the port physician to examine.

The Doric was 9 days and 16 hours from Yokohama. Mr Com fort, the new purser, who has run to this port on the City of Sydney, kindly furnished the following report:

Sailed from Hongkong Sept 21, 2:29 a. m., sailed from Macao Sept 21, 12:54 p. m., sailed from Shanghai Sept 21, 4:25 p. m., sailed from Nagasaki Sept 26, 8:0 p. m., sailed from Kobe Sept 28, 3:30 p. m., sailed from Yokohama Oct 1, 2:50 p. m., arrived at Honolulu Oct 10, 10:00 a. m.

The health among the immigrants is excellent. Among the passengers for this port is Dr. Schwartz a brother of Chaplain Schwartz of the New York Volunteers.
