## EXTRADITION WITH HAWAII

Washington, Aug. 11. — The State Department has determined upon a general policy of extradition between this country, Hawaii and other territory in whole or in part under the direction of the United States.

A number of cases have lately arisen in which fugitives from justice have claimed immunity by going to Cuba or our insular possessions on the theory that our relations with these places were in such a transitory condition that the usual processes of extradition would not apply.

The question was recently brought before the State Department, only as to Cuba and Hawaii and a general ruling was made that if fugitives were located in these countries, an application for extradition made in the usual form to the State Department would be turned over to the military administration and such steps taken as to secure the extradition on the ordinary prima facie evidence. The same rule will apply as to persons from Cuba, Hawaii, Porto Rico or the Philippines who seek refuge in the United States.

### GENERAL NEWS NOTES.

Dewey has arrived at Leghorn. He announces he will not visit England.

The steamer City of Sydney has again been chartered for transport service.

John Jacob Astor has renounced his brother William Waldorf Astor who has become a British citizen.

Heidelberg, Germany, Aug. 16. — Professor Robert Wilhelm Eberhard Bunsen, the chemist, is dead, aged 89 years.

President McKinley will not meet Dewey at the New York reception. The fall glory of the occasion will be centered in the Admiral.

New York politicians says Governor Roosevelt will be nominated for Vice-President in the next national Republican ticket. Hobart's health may force him to withdraw.

Terrible hurricanes have spread death and disaster throughout Porto Rico. Secretary Root has called on the Governors of the States to assist in the relief of the many destitute.

London, August 11. — The announcement of the closure of the Philippine ports caused great excitement in the London market today. Manila hemp, which rose 50 shilling a ton, touched £39 (\$195), the highest figure reached in many years.

Washington, Aug. 14. — Secretary of War Root issued an appeal today to the Governors of States, inviting their co operation in the Porto Rican relief work, in which appeal the Secretary says that the needs of the people in Porto Rico are much greater than at first supposed.

Washington, Aug. 15. — The Navy Department has been greatly relieved by a dispatch from Captain Longnecker, who commands the cruiser New Orleans, now at San Domingo city, referring to his vessel and the Machias. The dispatch gives definite assurance that all is well with the two ships. They will proceed to St. Thomas to coal.

Washington, Aug. 16. — The auxiliary cruiser Panther has been temporarily transferred to the War Department for use in the transportation of Porto Rican relief supplies collected in Baltimore and Philadelphia. The appalling conditions existing in Porto Rico were made more fully known to the War Department today by General Davis in a dispatch which says the deaths outright in the island will reach 200 while many are dying daily from injuries and privations.
