New York, January 10.—A cable to the World from Paris says: The Vanderbilt and Rockefeller weddings have found a queer echo here. All the newspapers published long articles about the millionaire marriages with wonderful comments on the stupendous fortunes existing in the United States. The oddest commentary of all was the meeting Thursday night of ten men in a private cardroom of the Rue Royale Club.

There were only two absentees of a dozen young noblemen, playfully styling themselves "Les Taisseurs," which literally means "Fleecers." The sole object of the organization is mutual aid in obtaining rich wives. Five former members married heiresses within the last three years. A meeting was called as the result of the millionaire marriages in the United States.

In the discussion, these weddings were declared to be very deplorable events. Every member regarded himself as personally aggrieved, and the opinion was expressed that the organization hereafter must endeavor to demonstrate the impropriety of American heiresses marrying Americans. Before adjourning the Taisseurs roundly denounced Count Boni de Castellane for comporting himself so as to discredit French noblemen and lessen the chances of their marrying Americans.


