DR. MORRISON TALKS

HAWAII SHOULD HAVE HER SHARE OF TOURISTS

TELLS HOW ISLANDS SHOULD BE ADVERTISED - NO BETTER PLACE IN WORLD FOR SANATORIUM.

Dr. N. H. Morrison, chief surgeon of the Santa Fe railway, with headquarters in Los Angeles, Cal., has taken up his abode in the Young hotel and like all who have moved into that popular hostelry, is sounding its praises to those whom he has met.

Denies investigation (Continued from Page 1.) fee yesterday, but I did not send for them. I sent for them a few days ago to question them in regard to certain statements that had been made in order to be prepared in case further proceedings should be necessary.

The Attorney General denied that he was engaged in any investigation into the conduct of J. Alfred Magoon or George A. Davis or any other attorney in the Sumner business.

It is indeed intimated by some that, although Attorney General Andrews is not engaged in any further investigations, the questions referred to him by the Supreme Court were preliminary to a possible further examination of the Sumner case circumstances.

Attorney General Andrews has been excused from filing a brief in the Humphreys and Thompson matter. Respondents have not yet filed briefs and will in all probability not do so.

John K. Sumner is said to be postponing his long contemplated journey to Tahiti to await the outcome of the disbarment proceedings.

It was stated at the Court House today that notwithstanding Andrews' assertion to the contrary, the Supreme Court had officially requested him to continue his investigation of the acts of attorneys in the Sumner case.
