VAGRANTS CROWD JAILS

New York, Jan. 15.—The unprecedented increase in vagrants in New York has caused congestion at the City Workhouse on Blackwell's Island and every effort possible is being made to relieve the overcrowding by transferring prisoners sentenced to long terms in the penitentiary to the Raymond-street jail in Brooklyn. There are today more than 700 women and more than 900 men in the workhouse, most of them serving terms for vagrancy.

Thousands out of work and among strangers, looking for work because of the closing down of factories in nearby cities, have increased the number of vagrants far beyond the usual number even in winter, and with the advent of a really cold spell all the city institutions will be crowded to overflowing.

The difficulty in securing work in New York just now has affected thousands of men and women who by no means belong to the tramp class but who have been forced into the streets because of lack of work.
