

# "UNDESIRABLES" CANNOT REMAIN

Bad Conduct Men Discharged From the Marine Corps Sent to the Coast—A Great Benefit to Hawaii.

The glorious climate of Hawaii will prove rather unhealthy for those men belonging to the local marine corps who through indiscretion come under the ban of official displeasure and are dropped from the service because of bad conduct.

The United States army transport Buford leaving Honolulu for San Francisco carried two men who had been discharged from the Marine corps because of conduct unbecoming a member of the service.

Such however is not the case. The existing military or naval regulations expressly provide that no member of the service who through bad conduct can be discharged at a foreign port Honolulu in the eyes of the Washington government is a foreign port and comes under the same status as with the Philippines or ports in Porto Rico or any other point in Uncle Sam's out laying possessions.
