AUTO ACCIDENTS DURING YESTERDAY

CLOSE CALLS IN EVERY INSTANCE

Chauffeurs Were Lucky That No Deaths or Broken Bones Resulted From the Bad Mixups.

Sunday was a bad day for auto smashups, according to reports turned in. Three accidents occurred and each of them was close enough to the fatal line to cause a shudder.

The first of the series occurred on a sharp curve on the Paoli road, when an auto driven by Fred Noyes crashed through the fence and hung on a balance over a precipice. Had the car moved six inches further there would have been another story to tell about a wrecked car and broken bones, if no worse. In this instance a small tree saved the occupants from a bad fall.

Accident number two came to pass on the same road on which Miss Harriet Smith was killed but a short time ago. A machinist from Wahiawa was in the car, accompanied by a lady friend. A Japanese was driving the machine. According to the story told of the accident, just as the car was rounding a sharp curve the machinist reached over and pulled the throttle wide open, causing the machine to make a jump and then turn completely over.

Strange to say, no one was injured.

The third accident happened when an auto came shooting out of an alley on King street and plunked into an electric car that was passing at the time. The auto hit the car fair in the middle, and the result was that the auto was brought to a full stop and swung to one side. The machine was somewhat damaged, having a wheel knocked off and its engine put out of commission. Had the machine been a few seconds sooner, the car would have hit it good and fair and the result might have been serious.
