ASKS DISSOLUTION OF PARTNERSHIP

Dondero of Hawaiian Realty Company Prays for Accounting by Kirkpatrick—Bill Filed Yesterday.

Lorrin Andrews, attorney for A. H. Dondero of the Hawaiian Realty Company, filed a bill in equity in the Circuit Court yesterday afternoon against L. Kirkpatrick, Dondero's partner in the real estate business, asking for an accounting and dissolution of the partnership.

The bill sets forth that the two men entered into an oral co-partnership September 17, 1909, for buying and selling real estate, acquiring 23 acres divided into 120 lots, which was named Wai'alaia Heights. Each was to devote his entire time to the business and the profits were to be shared equally.

According to the plaintiff's claims, Kirkpatrick has not attended to business since March 1, is not around to sign deeds or contracts and has collected money for the business for which he has never accounted.

For these reasons the plaintiff prays that Kirkpatrick be summoned to answer and to make an accounting for all money received and expended by him on account of the firm, and that the co-partnership be dissolved and the property of the firm placed in the hands of a receiver.
