## NEW COTTON BILL THROUGH

(Associated Press Cable.)

WASHINGTON, D. C., Aug. 3.—

Tariff downward was the general cry in Congress today, when the cotton schedule providing for a duty of 30 per cent, ad valorem was passed by the House in the face of determined opposition from the regulars and insurgents.

The insurgent Republicans failed to line up for the bill, dissenting on the ground that it was a manufactured tariff.

Hope to Override Veto.

The Democrats in the House are preparing for their attempt to pass the wool schedule, known as the La Follette compromise, over the President's veto, taking it for granted he will disapprove of the bill. They are seeking a compromise with the insurgents.

Representative Underwood forced the placing of lemons on the free list, striking a blow at one of the great California industries. There is said to be little chance of its passing in the Senate at this session.

## ORDERED AMERICAN FLAGS TAKEN DOWN

LONDON, Ont., Aug. 2.—On the ground that the Union Jack had been shown discourtesy in Detroit, the chairman of the Old Boys' Association here today ordered all the American flags on the streets of this city to be taken down.

## TOBACCO TRUST IS HELD UP.

NEW YORK, N. Y., Aug. 3.—On a mandate from the United States Supreme Court, the United States Circuit Court for the Southern District of New York today issued a decree enjoining the American Tobacco Company from enlarging its combination.

The decree holds that pending its reorganization the tobacco trust can not consistently proceed with its consolidation, under penalty of a receivership being formed.

## LIEUTENANT KILLS HIMSELF.

NEW YORK, Aug. 3.—Lieutenant Brillhart, United States navy, was found shot through the head in a hotel here today. The coroner pronounced it a case of suicide. No cause is known for the deed.

## MOYER IS REELECTED.

BUTTE, Mont., Aug. 2.—At the annual convention of the Western Federation of Miners here today, Moyer was reelected president of the organization.

## FIRE IN PARLIAMENT HOUSE.

TORONTO, Can., Aug. 3.—Fire broke out in the west wing of the Parliament buildings today, but it was soon subdued with comparatively little loss.

## TOGO ARRIVES.

NEW YORK, Aug. 3.—Vice-Admiral Togo of the Japanese navy arrived in this city at midnight on the Lusitania from Southampton.

## JUDGE'S DIARY IS A FINE WORK OF ART

There is a diary lying on Judge W. J. Robinson's desk in the Circuit Court that is a work of art. The judge is one of those who learned what was termed "lawyers' writing," which was used throughout before the typewriter came into use for legal documents.

Page after page of it is there in the straight-up-and-down writing, but occasionally when there is a holiday to be celebrated the judge catches the infection of the moment and breaks forth into fancy designs. Independence Day, for instance, is done in big letters with fancy attachments hung onto them. The top half of the words are in red and the bottom half in blue. Other holidays are marked throughout the book up to next Christmas, but the one that shows the true soul of the artist is St. Patrick's Day. This is done in the same fancy letters, but it is also further marked out by being printed in green ink. When you turn over the pages it shouts "Erin go bragh!" at you.
