The sugar season on Kauai may be said to have resumed the usual activity as the inward cargoes in the inter-island steamer Hall include the regulation 5500 sacks sugar from Garden Island plantations. The vessel was an arrival this morning with a quantity of empty gasoline drums, 45 coconuts plants, one auto and 38 packages sundries in addition to the consignment of sugar. Purser Logan reports strong northeast winds and rough seas on the return trip.

Articles of incorporation of the Deglet Noor Dair Company were filed with the Treasurer yesterday. The company has been formed with local capital to work a date farm at Mecca, California.
