LATEST NEWS IN ARMY AND NAVY CIRCLES

WASHINGTON, D. C., May 5.—The ordnance department of the army announces that it will be able to begin the distribution of automatic 45-caliber revolvers, model of 1911, to the organized militia of the States, about December 1, 1912.

In the meantime the ordnance department can supply to each State not to exceed twenty revolvers with extra magazines, holsters, and ammunition, charging them to the quota of the State through the division of militia affairs, or the revolvers may be sold to the States for cash under the provisions of the law.

The price of the new fire arm is \$14.75. A leather pocket to carry extra magazine, and web pockets to be worn on the field belt, are being designed by the ordnance department.

The appointment of a special board to devise a practical plan for the consolidation of the revenue cutter service, life-saving service, lighthouse service and the coast and geodetic survey is proposed in a bill which Senator Martine of New Jersey has introduced.

The board directed to draft a plan of consolidation is to be composed of two persons representing the maritime interests of the United States, two representing the Department of Commerce and Labor, two representing the revenue cutter service, one officer of the navy with experience in the lighthouse service, one officer of the navy with experience in the coast survey and one civilian official of the government with experience in hydrographic and triangulation surveys along the Mississippi river. The board is to be appointed by the President.

It is also proposed to consolidate the various services in a bureau of the Navy Department, to be known as the coast guard bureau. This is to form no constituent part of the navy except in time of war.

The board is especially instructed to report to Congress an estimate of the economies which will result from the consolidation proposed. The bill was referred to the Senate committee on naval affairs.

Gen. Leonard Wood, Gen. Oscar Crozier and several members of a special army board were at Fort Myer at the test of a new automatic rifle that is being tried out by the War Department.

The gun weighs only twenty-five pounds and fires at the rate of 500 shots a minute, the ammunition being in circular cases of twenty-five service cartridges each. The feature of the gun is that it is air cooled, a draft of air being forced through the casing of the barrel by the power generated in its discharge.

At a range of 100 yards the bullets ate out the target like the spread of a spoonful of acid.

After nine years' work, interrupted by many accidents, and the expenditure of about \$6,000,000, dry dock No. 4 at the navy yard, New York, is completed and will be turned over to the government by the contractors next week, a year ahead of contract time. This dock is known as the "hoodon dock," because of the number of workmen who have been killed or injured during its construction. It will accommodate any battleship in the United States navy, in commission or under construction. The first vessel to go into it will be the battleship Utah, which is booked for extensive repairs.

For the last ten years most of the decisions rendered by the judge advocate general of the army, though exceedingly important in many cases, have been a sealed book to the army as a whole, having been scattered and unclassified and generally inaccessible. After a year's hard work that fault has been remedied by Capt. Charles R. Howland, 21st infantry, attaché to the judge advocate general's office. He has just compiled and printed a digest of these opinions.
