The Southern Methodist church has exerted a most powerful influence in the South through its educational institutions. It has done a great work, a pioneer work, too, in education, and is still doing great things in that line. Since its estrangement from Vanderbilt, the fine university the church fostered for a generation or more, it has not been discouraged in this branch of its activities, but has rather renewed and expanded its activities in the building of two great universities, one in Texas and the other in Georgia. These institutions are now well under way and are receiving splendid financial support. They are all right, too, and will be useful, but we have often felt that, while the Methodist church is seeking these new fields for investing great sums of money, it might with good grace, and perhaps even greater benefit, do more for two great old institutions of the church of which we have some knowledge.

One of these is Wofford College, in this city, while the other is Emory and Henry College, at Emory, Va. Both have stood the test of time, fighting the great fight, largely through the power and force of the men who have been directly interested in them. Both have rendered great service to the church and to the state; far greater service, perhaps, than have the more flashy universities into which the church has put its millions, but they have never been supported or recognized as they should have been by the church of the whole section.

These institutions have been faithful in a few things—in small things—and they should be made able to exert the wholesome influence that surrounds them over many and greater things. Had the Southern Methodist church, when it sought to find an outlet for its educational enthusiasm, following the experience with Vanderbilt, turned to Wofford and Emory and Henry and made of these fine old colleges, which have given the church the great majority of its leaders, great universities, it would have been a proper and most fitting expression of gratitude.

Look over the bishops and leaders of the Southern Methodist church today and you will find that the major-

ity of them came from Wofford and Emory and Henry. They could have done more for these colleges.

Screwdriver for Any Screw.
