ADDRESS OF Maj. R. H. FORSTER, Delivered before the Reunion of the Veterans Club of Centre county at Howard Pa., Sep. 22nd, 1877.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, AND COMRADES OF THE VETERAN CLUB OF CENTRE COUNTY.—As appropriate to the occasion...

MILITIA OF 1862 AND 1863. In the militia called into service for protection of the State in 1862...

Under the first call for 75,000 men to serve three months, the State of Pennsylvania furnished twenty-five regiments.

While it was not the fortune of these troops to pass through bloody battles, they doubtless experienced many of the toils, hardships and privations of an army campaign in the field.

Early in the month of August, 1862, and partly with a view to save Centre county from the operations of the draft then pending, it was thought that a regiment of volunteers might be raised in addition to the numerous companies already in the field from the county.

THE THREE YEARS SERVICE. The battle of Bull Run was fought July 20th, 1861, and while its results were indeed humiliating to the Union...

Company B, 148th Reg.; Company C, 148th Reg.; Company D, 148th Reg.; Company F, 148 Reg.; Company G, 148th Reg.; Company H, 148th Regiment.

We have seventeen companies, or an aggregate of 1,600 men. In addition to these companies credited wholly to Centre county, Company B, of the 45th, is credited to Centre and Lancaster; Company D, of the 53d, to Centre and Clearfield; Company I, of the 56th, to Centre and Luzerne; Company F, 2d Cavalry, to Centre and Clearfield; Company E, 7th Cavalry, to Centre and Clinton; Company E, of the 93d, to Centre and Clinton, and Company K, of the 110th, to Centre and Clearfield.

Centre county was represented in these regiments by five companies, as follows: Company H, 2d Regiment; Company H, 4th Regiment; Company H, 7th Regiment; Company B, 10th Regiment; Company I, 15th Regiment.

and Glencoe, covering about twelve miles of the railroad, with the regimental headquarters at Cockeyville. The battles of South Mountain and Antietam were in the meantime fought and the tide of war again flowed back to Virginia.

The armies in Virginia confronted each other at Fredericksburg, and in the month of December, the 148th was ordered from the pleasant camps of the past three months to the front.

We marched to Chancellorsville, and in the struggle of May 1st, 2nd and 3d, 1863, the metal of our ranks was first tested, and the severity of the test is shown by the long sad list of killed and wounded.
