The Election.

We have met the enemy and we are there. After a hard and fiercely fought battle the democracy have carried the State by a decided working majority, which secures to them the United States Senator for the next six years in the place of the present incumbent, Hon. Mr. Pearce. To this they only hold their own, as Mr. Pearce is a Democrat. The Opposition or Union party did not in all Allegany. Contending with an odds against them of some five hundred votes, they have succeeded in electing two members of the Legislature, the Sheriff, two Commissioners and one member of the Orphan's Court.

This was nobly done, and old Allegany has covered herself with glory. If the Opposition had had the most remote idea that they could have done so well they would have done better still, and we will rejoice over their success. But while we do so we do not forget that we are still a Democracy. The Opposition or Union party did not in all Allegany. Contending with an odds against them of some five hundred votes, they have succeeded in electing two members of the Legislature, the Sheriff, two Commissioners and one member of the Orphan's Court.

The flying colors which our noble and talented standard bearer, the Hon. H. W. Hoffman, passed over and out of this county, naturally led us to expect, as we had a right to do, that Washington and Frederick counties would have done as well as we had done. Our friends in Frederick, at least, have suffered themselves to be frightened from their confidence in the rightness of the vote. That it has been so evident from the vote in that county, and away from the immediate scene of Brown's operations, our candidate for Congress has made considerable gains, but in those precincts which were over the scene of the madman's exploits, his vote has fearfully fallen off from what it was two years ago. That it should be so is a matter of marvel to us, when it is known, as we charged before the election, that the whole responsibility of those fearful scenes that transpired at Harper's Ferry, is attributable to the ex-crescenting agitation of the negro question by the democracy. With that unscrupulousness for which it has been so long famed, it took hold of this transaction, and endeavored both publicly and privately to connect our candidate, and particularly our candidate for Congress, through his brother's vote, with this vile aggression on the soil of our own, and of a neighboring state. Finding themselves inadequate to his defeat by fair and honorable means, they resort to a base and vile slander to accomplish it, while the intellectual inability they put forward as their candidate, announced publicly from the rostrum, with an air of self gratification and triumph, that the Harper's Ferry insurrection would elect him. But it is useless for us to point out the causes that produced our defeat, or to lament over democratic excesses—we would rather counsel our friends to be of good cheer—rally to the contest. The hopes of the Union are upon the Opposition and Conservative element opposed to democracy. The discussion democracy may flourish for a season, but the sober second thought of the people will bring them right.
