DELIVERED HALL.—The season of the company which has been so pleasantly enjoyed by our citizens is about to be brought to a close. This Thursday night has been set apart for the benefit of Mr. J. T. THE DRAFT.—Orders have been issued for the draft to take place at the earliest possible day. In our last issue we called the attention of our friends to this subject volunteering if they would send us lists of the names of those who have enlisted from their districts, that we would send them to Headquarters and try to have our county set right on this question. We have received a list of forty-seven names for District No. 1 in this county and forwarded it to Annapolis. Allowances will be made up to the time the draft commences and the proper credits given. But if the necessary information is not furnished, of course the credit cannot be given.

FIRE.—The alarm of fire on Friday night was caused by the burning of Mr. A. P. Sheppard's dry goods store. The fire is supposed to have originated from the burning of the soot in the chimney at the back end of the building, falling down into the fire place and igniting the wooden fireboard. From this it communicated to a lot of carpeting and matting, and considerable damage was done before its discovery and the arrival of our efficient firemen with their apparatus. We have not learned the extent of damage to the stock of goods, nor can it be well ascertained until the Insurance Co. shall go to work. We understand Mr. Sheppard has a partial insurance, perhaps sufficient to cover the loss.

Changes.

We learn that an arrangement has been effected by which the Mount Savage Iron Company, the Frothingburg Coal Company, and the Ocean Steam Coal Company, (owning what is known as the "Aspinwall purchase," in the valley of George's Creek), have been consolidated, and have purchased the road of the Cumberland and Pennsylvania Railroad Company, running from Cumberland to Piedmont.

The consolidated company has organized under the charter of the "Consolidation Coal Company"—a charter obtained some years ago, but never till now put in operation. This charter is understood to be a liberal one, giving every required facility for the successful prosecution of the various operations of so large a company; and as the means of those in interest are ample, and their determination fixed to make this a practical enterprise, we may expect to see the business of coal mining in the county receive a new and powerful impetus.

Adams then pushed forward and defeated Everett's command, killing two of his officers and capturing thirty-five men.

NEW YORK, April 30.—The Newbern (N. C.) Times of the 27th, says: On Friday last a large Rebel force appeared in front of Little Washington, but their lines were soon deserted, and it is said a vigorous stampede toward Richmond commenced.

NEW YORK, April 30, 3.55 P. M.—The steamer City of Baltimore, with four hundred and ninety thousand, and Saxonia, with one hundred and seventy thousand dollars in specie, sailed today for Europe.

SENTENCE PASSED.—Wm. Stokes, of Frederick county, who was arrested a few months ago, on the charge of being a Rebel spy, has been tried by a Military Commission, found guilty, and sentenced to be confined at Fort McHenry during the war.—*Middleton Register.*
