NO SUMMER VACATION.

President Cleveland Not Given to Summer Trips.

WASHINGTON, March 28.—An inquiry at the White House as to where Mr. Cleveland would likely go during the hot months of summer, was met by the answer "to work." The President has not been in the habit, his friends say, of going away on summer trips, and seldom takes recreation of any considerable length of time. He is in the habit of taking walks and drives of frequent and regular intervals. He rises, dines, works and has his amusement at certain hours of the day. He is very steady in his habits, and being a man of robust build and natural good health, he has never found it necessary to take the kind of recreation other Presidents have.

One of Mr. Cleveland's friends from Albany says that the President cares nothing for fishing or gunning, and he will not be off on any excursions of that character. He has a way of discharging his mind of business when his day's work is over, and his rest is perfect. He sleeps well. His nerves are firm, regular and steady. He has no ailments, no suspense, nothing like remorse, and he is in an hour, ready to begin his day of a day. It is a blessing to have this disposition surely. It is the offspring of the true Philistine, classic constitution, and above all, absolute will power.

The men who call frequently at the White House speak of the uniform good nature of the President. He keeps an even temper, and has nothing like the dyspepsia. His digestion is good, and he makes those about him feel well with him.

Sunset Cox for Governor of New York.

WASHINGTON, March 28.—"It is not unlikely," said a New York Democratic member, to-day, "that Sunset Cox will only remain a few months in Turkey."

"Why?" your correspondent inquired.

"He will probably be our next candidate for Governor, and we will call him back to us."

"Do you think he would accept a nomination of that kind?"

"Yes, I do; and he would be elected. You see, the people of New York—and in fact, the whole country—have not realized what a useful man Cox is until now, when he is about quitting the country and leaving public life forever, for I understand he does not intend to re-enter public life. He is made of the same stuff as I am. I would rather have Cox of New York to-day, if I would rather have Governor's chances than those of any other man."

**NEWS OF NATIONAL INTEREST.**

Rumors Regarding the Oklahoma Boomers—Telegram From the Central and South American Cable Company, Etc.

WASHINGTON, March 28.—The War Department is informed that the Oklahoma boomers intended to invade the Indian Territory next Monday and march direct to the Oklahoma lands. General Hatch telegraphed to-day that Couch had informed his followers that they would not move at the time proposed. They are now at their old camps, and number about 800.

The secretary of the cable company has received the following telegram from the President of the Central and South American Cable Company, dated March 27:

"The following has just been received from the Superintendent of this company at Panama:

"The remainder of the commander of the Colombian gunboat service landed at the mouth of Buenaventura River yesterday, forced open the cable house of Central and South American Cable Company, and cut the company's cable. We have repaired the damages. Will you kindly instruct the commander of the United States naval vessel at Panama that the Colombian gunboat is still at anchor at the mouth of the Buenaventura River. It is uncertain whether the cable company will open the national forces of Colombia or those in rebellion, but we fear further injury to our cables, and interference with international communication."

The dispatch was referred to the Secretary of the Navy.

Commissioner of Pensions Clark has decided that a mother can not be allowed a pension as a dependent mother and the accused pension of her deceased husband be sent to her. He says: "Upon careful consideration of the laws relating to the subject I am of the opinion that when claims become dependent on the same person, making only one beneficiary, that person can not be allowed either directly or indirectly the benefit of two pensions for the same period of time. Such allowance would be contrary to the provisions of the statute, which declares that pension laws shall not be construed so as to allow more than one pension in the same time to the same person."

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs to-day issued schedules of the supplies to be sent by the Indians this spring, including \$1,500,000 worth of beef and \$750,000 worth of dry goods. Advertisements for proposals will be printed in Democratic newspapers hereafter.

It is understood that J. B. Baird, son-in-law of Senator Colquhoun of Georgia, will shortly be appointed Chief of the Board of Examiners in accordance with the provisions of the last Indian Appropriation bill. Commissioner Atkins of the Indian Bureau, has ordered the removal of Joseph Bird's Nez Perce Indians from the Indian Territory. Of the 282 Indians composing this band, 112 will be sent to Colorado, and the remainder to the Lapwai Reservation, in Idaho Territory.

The Washingtons have been ordered from Panama to La Palou, San Salvador.

Ex-President Arthur, accompanied by Senator Campbell, Mr. and Mrs. McMichael and Miss Wallach, left Washington this afternoon for Monroe. A large number of friends, including members of the ex-President's Cabinet, who are new in the city, several members of the diplomatic corps, and a number of army and navy officers and many ladies and gentlemen, well known in private life, gathered at the Baltimore and Ohio station to see the party off.

The recently organized Gridiron Club of Washington's Correspondents gave a second monthly dinner to-night at Walker's. Among the guests were Senators Sherman, Palmer and Teller. Representative Reed of Maine, Lieutenant General Sheridan, Hon. Epps Hanson of Virginia, Hon. Richard T. Merrick, W. E. Quimby, of the Detroit Free Press; Mr. Wilson Hutchinson, of the Washington Post; W. S. Andrews, of New York, and John Addison Porter.

The Secretary of the Navy to-day issued a circular for the information of all government of all concerned, stating the provisions of the law enacted during the closing hours of last Congress, which provides that, from this date, the Assistant Ensigns in the Navy shall be promoted during the three years, after the date of which they take rank as passed First Assistants, when at sea \$3,000, when on shore duty \$2,200. During and after the fourth and fifth years after such date, when at sea \$2,700, on shore duty \$2,000, and when on leave or waiting orders \$1,500.

Regarding that Spurious Report.

WASHINGTON, March 28.—The statement of ex-Senator Hill, published to-day in a dispatch from Denver, denying the responsibility for the spurious report issued from the Government Printing Office as a report of the Senate Committee on Postoffice and Post Roads, and asserting that the only report that he (Hill) ever ordered printed was that of the committee investigation, printed in the summer of 1874, was shown this afternoon to the late clerk of the committee, who was also the Private Secretary of the Chairman, Senator Hill. This gentleman though reluctant to submit to be interviewed, said in reply to direct interrogatories that he had given the order for the printing matter in question, and had done so by direction of Mr. Hill.

He gave the order on the 13th and 14th of this month, and had received instructions of Mr. Hill to do so about a month before. He (the clerk) assumed the responsibility for the delay of a report in regarding the matter contained in the report the clerk said he had himself copied the questions propounded to the President of the Senate, and the answers thereto, and had received the newspaper clippings, of which four files of the spurious reports consisted, from Senator Hill himself. Mr. Hill denies that he ordered any copy to be printed. The ex-Clerk admits having received the file before yesterday, from Senator Hill himself, and says he took them to the folding room to be folded. "To be folded and directed to whom was asked."

"To be folded in blank," the gentleman declined to state to whom the copies of the spurious document were to be sent, and declined to answer any further questions.

The members of the Senate Committee, whom somebody, apparently acting through Senator Hill, intended to make responsible for the spurious publication, are exceedingly indignant. They invited investigation entirely of their own motion, and have no orders, as the document room that no more copies shall be given out to anyone.

**Central American War News.**

WASHINGTON, March 28.—Information has been received here to-day to the effect that a movement is on foot to overthrow the government of Honduras, and to favor an alliance of the people of that country with the people of Nicaragua, Costa Rica and San Salvador against General Barrios. The movement is reported to have originated with Marco Aurelio Soto, President of Honduras, now in New York City. Since Barrios' announcement to make himself "supreme military ruler of the Central American States," Soto said to have been quietly working to break the alliance of Honduras with Guatemala. The people of Honduras, it is understood, are opposed to Barrios, and are only waiting for an opportunity to break away from him. They are therefore willing to join forces with Nicaragua in an attempt to overthrow their own government.

The Nicaraguan forces, it is asserted, will number 6,000 men, and will cross the border of Honduras and aid in the revolution, with the addition of the opponents of Barrios in Honduras. It is said an army of 50,000 men can be raised by the States of Central America, in resistance to the pretensions of the President of Guatemala.

**DEAD FOR NEARLY A MONTH.**

A Little Girl Put in Her Coffin Comes to Life After Twenty-Eight Days.

NORTH HOPE, March 28.—A very peculiar case of suspended animation and abstinence from food for a period of twenty-eight days at Marion Township, this county, is exciting great interest. A little daughter of Joseph Renner was taken suddenly ill with colic, and the pain was so severe that she went into spasms. The father went after a doctor, but the child was to all appearances dead before the physician arrived. The heart had ceased to beat, the pulse was extinct and respiration had ceased. It was noticed, however, in two or three hours after she had died, that the skin did not take on that peculiar pallor noticeable on most dead people. The child looked as though she were sleeping, though the doctor pronounced her dead. The body was kept for two days, and during that time the skin retained its color, but no other signs of life were manifested. Then the friends commenced dissecting the propriety of burying her.

While the dissection was in progress, the child went into the room where the child was lying, and, after looking at the corpse for a moment, put his fingers on the pulse and was surprised to feel it fluttering. The pulse beat slowly, but it indicated that life was there, and means were at once used to fan the vital spark into a flame. The doctor was again called and, after a short examination, declared that the child was not dead, but that she had been in a state of torpidity for twenty-eight days. On the evening of the twenty-sixth day she opened her eyes and feebly asked for a drink of water. From that time she gained strength and is now able to get about. From the time she took milk until the day she refused to eat, she was kept in a room where during that time she partook of no food. Whenever an attempt was made to open her mouth the muscles controlling her jaw became rigid and her mouth could not be opened.

**WHEATON'S MURDER TRIAL.**

All the Testimony In—The Prisoners Flippancy—Grief of Mrs. Fletcher and Her Daughter.

WHEATON, Ill., March 28.—The Hope-Fletcher murder trial is nearing the end, and as time passes the interest grows more intense. The court-room yesterday morning was crowded, and more women were present. Merritt Fletcher was the last witness examined. Like his father, he gave his testimony slowly, deliberately and with a flippancy that utterly killed any sentiment that had been previously shown in his favor.

State Attorney G. Cooper, of De Witt County, opened the arguments for the prosecution. His speech was a short review of the case. He was followed by G. DeWitt, for the defense, who principally in rebuttal of Mr. Cooper's remarks. Attorney Russell, of Kane County, followed with an elaborate consuming and forty minutes. When the speaker mentioned the chances the prisoners are running of being executed, he burst into a violent fit of weeping, which continued through the remainder of the day. Her daughter remained more calm, crying at times. Both father and son, however, remained as stoical and indifferent as a man. Only once did the former evince signs of nervousness. A portion of the time he held his wife's hand, which was the only consolation attempted. The son, Merritt, was especially indifferent, and seemed totally oblivious of the fact that his father was at stake. He was only once tortured his countenance, however, when suggested some mental feeling. Mr. Shissler made the closing argument and spoke for an hour. He spoke deliberately and eloquently, but in a way that showed he thought there was little hope for the prisoners. Judge E. H. Gentry made the closing address to the jury, and the case will be given to the jury to-day.

The feeling against the prisoners ran very high yesterday, and while Merritt Fletcher was giving his testimony many an audible murmur was heard in the room.

Counsel for the defense say they will take an appeal should the jury return any other verdict than that of acquittal.

**ESCAPED LYING.**

Palmer, the Accomplice of Young Berner, Whose Mistrial Caused the Cincinnati Riot, Has a Narrow Escape From a Mob.

CINCINNATI, March 28.—Palmer, the accomplice of young Berner, whose mistrial was the immediate cause of the outbreak a year ago, was arraigned yesterday for a second trial, and his attorney asked that the jury be sent to view the premises where the murder was committed. The Prosecuting Attorney was willing such an order should be made, but insisted that the defendant should accompany the jury, holding that it was a right which could not be waived. The suggestion that Berner should accompany the jury caused a significant movement in the crowd, and recognizing the danger, Palmer's attorney protested against his client being allowed to enter the jury, and the jury proceeded out into the street, and a mob swelled to hundreds, Palmer, for whom they were waiting, was quickly taken to the jail by a back way. When it was discovered that he had been done the crowd became noisy, and dared the officers to bring him out into the street. Palmer's attorney remarked to-night that he is certain that the prisoner has been sent with the jury his dead body would have been in the morgue within an hour.

**General Grant.**

NEW YORK, March 28.—General Grant did not sleep before midnight, and at that hour Colonel Grant administered a hypodermic injection of morphia and the General then slept. After breakfast he went driving in Central Park, accompanied by Mrs. Grant, Mrs. Sartoris and Mrs. Fred Grant.

Dr. Douglas was very tired when seen to-night, after leaving the residence of General Grant, but reported that the General had passed a good day, and had slept from 2 until 6 o'clock in the morning, and after breakfast went to drive. In the afternoon he went out again, accompanied

by Senor Romero and Dr. Douglas. He was rather quiet in the carriage, but talking as much as usual. Dr. Douglas said there was no marked change in General's condition during the day, nor any complaint of pain in the throat. He took food regularly, and on returning from the afternoon drive enjoyed a nap. He retired to bed about 10:30, and was being taken to induce sleep. Regular convalescence to-morrow.

**Secession from the Amalgamated Association.**

WHEELING, W. Va., March 28.—An event that is of more than ordinary interest to the trade unions of the country is the secession from the great amalgamated association of all the local assemblies in the Wheeling district, the great hall center of the United States. The Bohloire Tribune, which is posted on the situation, says: "This action is taken partly in consequence of the disunion of the local head offices, and partly because there has been a constant clash in the association and has since the introduction of the steel ball. The iron cutters and the puddlers have been fighting the steel ball cutters, and as they are in the majority the steel ball cutters were powerless in the association, and as all the mills in this (the second) amalgamated district, with two exceptions, have adopted the steel ball and will make it generally a big one and causes a little complaint, the puddlers have decided to withdraw and form an organization of their own, independent of all other branches of the association.
