MILITARY APPROPRIATIONS.

Army Officers Want Them Increased.

WASHINGTON, April 18.—A group of army officers, including General Bennett, Chief of Ordnance, were discussing the Anglo-Russian imbroglio yesterday in the Treasury Department, and making comparisons of the several militia forces of the European countries, when General Bennett said: "Our standing army is small. For the defense of the country we must rely on the militia. The militia should, therefore, be kept in the best condition possible for actual service. Volunteer organizations in every State and Territory should be encouraged and every effort made to promote their efficiency in drill and discipline, and make them skillful in the use of their arms. It is the best way and the only way to render them a sure and reliable reliance on the breaking out of war, and before a little campaigning has insured them to hard service and discipline, then into old soldiers. The amount appropriated by the act of 1868 (\$20,000,000) to move, completely arm and equip the whole body of the militia, should be largely increased. It should be invited to this very important subject." The officers present heartily concurred with General Bennett in his conclusions, and expressed the hope that the Forty-ninth Congress take needed action in the premises.

It is said that a Randall man will come to the front in the early part of the session with a bill to reduce the tariff, nothing resembling a horizontal bill, however. Other important bills which are likely to pass are one debating civil service reform; also a bill amendatory of Edmunds' Polygamy law.

The Secretary of the Treasury Issues a Circular to the Customs Officers—Appointments.

WASHINGTON, April 18.—The Secretary of the Treasury issued the following circular to the customs officers in regard to the reimportation of distilled spirits:

"In an opinion of the Attorney General, quoted in Decision 5823, of July 21, 1883, the question was decided in the negative. It is in accordance with the spirit of the law that distilled spirits manufactured in the United States and shipped to foreign countries without payment of the internal revenue tax and subsequently returned to the United States, should be treated as spirits of the United States. The opinion of the Attorney General was that a shipment and return of such spirits under the provisions of the act of March 3, 1879, and upon such return duty was assessed under Section 2309 of the Revised Statutes, and the quantity returned by the customs officer, without correction of errors for leakage, required by the internal revenue regulations. The department decides that, on the facts stated, the spirits should be treated as spirits of the United States, and that therefore the merchandise was not entitled to entry under Section 2309 of the Revised Statutes. When a Collector of Customs shall receive such domestic merchandise from a foreign port, and in the original distiller's packages, and the facts bring the case within the rule stated, he will deliver the same to the collector of the district, who will dispose of the same and the duties thereon as provided by the Commissioner of Internal Revenue.
