From the Albany Argus. AN ACT to provide for the Collection, Safe Keeping, Transfer, and Disbursement of the Public Revenue.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That there shall be prepared and provided, within the new Treasury building, now erecting at the seat of Government, suitable and convenient rooms for the use of the Treasurer of the United States...

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That the Mint of the United States, in the city of Philadelphia, in the State of Pennsylvania, and the Branch Mint in the city of New Orleans, in the State of Louisiana, and the vaults and safes thereof, respectively, shall be places of deposit and safe keeping of the public moneys at those points respectively...

Sec. 3. And be it further enacted, That there shall be prepared and provided, within the custom houses now erecting in the city of New York, in the State of New York, and in the city of Boston, in the State of Massachusetts, suitable and convenient rooms for the use of the receivers-general of public moneys, hereinafter directed to be appointed, at those places, respectively...

Sec. 4. And be it further enacted, That there shall be erected, prepared and provided, at the expense of the United States, at the city of Charleston, in the State of South Carolina, and at the city of St. Louis, in the State of Missouri, offices, with suitable and convenient rooms for the use of the receivers-general of public moneys, hereinafter directed to be appointed at the places above named...

Sec. 5. And be it further enacted, That the President shall nominate, and by and with the advice and consent of the Senate appoint four officers, to be denominated "receivers-general of public moneys," which said officers shall hold their offices for the term of four years, unless sooner removed therefrom...

Sec. 6. And be it further enacted, That the Treasurer of the United States, the treasurer of the Mint of the United States, the treasurers, and those acting as such, of the various Branch Mints, all collectors of the customs, all surveyors of the customs acting also as collectors, all receivers-general of public moneys, collectors of public moneys at the several land offices, all postmasters except as hereinafter particularly provided, be, and they are hereby, required to keep safely, without loaning or using, all the public money collected by them, or otherwise at any time placed in the possession and custody of any officer of the Government to be transferred or paid out...

Sec. 7. And be it further enacted, That the Treasurer of the United States, the Treasurer of the Mint of the United States, the Treasurer of the Branch Mint at New Orleans, and the receivers-general of the public money hereinafter directed to be appointed, shall, respectively, give bonds to the United States in such form, and for such amounts, as shall be directed by the Secretary of the Treasury, by and with the advice and consent of the President, with securities to the satisfaction of the Solicitor of the Treasury...

Sec. 8. And be it further enacted, That it shall be the duty of the Secretary of the Treasury, as early as a day as possible after the year...
