EMIGRATION EASTWARD.

A correspondent of the Hartford (Ct.) Observer writes as follows from Jacksonville, Fla.

We met from time to time on our way, a considerable number of pale and sallow visaged travellers, who were returning from the "far west," to their former residence—with ordinary horses, old wagons, and with every appearance of poverty and dejection.

A MATTER OF COMMERCE.—A writer in the Boston Courier, who furnishes information not without interest in some commercial circles, expresses the opinion that if the trade between China and India in British ships, is stopped, and our intercourse with Canton is not interrupted by the British fleet, a very large amount of American tonnage would find employment in transporting cotton from Bombay and Calcutta to China.

According to the present laws of the Anglo-Indian government, American ships have a right to carry on the trade to which we have turned out, and that our ship-owners have not availed themselves of the opening the past eight months.

HAZARDS OF IRON.

Mr. Wilkinson, of London, lately presented to the Asiatic Society a paper upon the spontaneous heating cast iron when brought into the air after it had been for many years under salt water.

It was observed, also, that all lost about 36 per cent. of their weight. An iron ring, from one of the guns, was placed upon the table; but of wrought iron, it had not exhibited the phenomena shown by the cast iron, and was merely oxidized.
