THE ANNUAL TREASURY REPORT.

The Annual Report of the Secretary of the Treasury, yesterday laid before Congress, states the Receipts and Expenditures for 1840 as follows:

RECEIPTS.

The receipts and means for 1840, exclusive of trusts and the Post Office, have been as follows:

Table with 2 columns: Description of receipts and their amounts. Includes 'The available balance on the 1st of January, 1840, is computed to have been \$2,246,749 00'.

EXPENDITURES.

The expenditures for 1840, exclusive of trusts and the Post Office, have been as follows:

Table with 2 columns: Description of expenditures and their amounts. Includes 'For first three quarters, Civil, Diplomatic, and Miscellaneous 4,118,248 64'.

RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES FOR 1841.

In hastily running our eye over the Report, we gather that the Receipts under existing laws are estimated to be probably as follows:

EXPENDITURES.

Ordinary purposes, if Congress make no reduction in the appropriations requested by the different Departments, estimated at \$19,250,000.

This would leave at the close of the year, a balance estimated at \$4,500,000.

But certain payments must also be made on account of the funded and unfunded debt, unless Congress authorize contracts to be formed for their payment; and the time of their payment; thus there will be required on account of the funded debt \$4,649,200.

Estimated balance in the Treasury at the close of the year 1841, after all payments whatsoever, \$824,273.

This is all the information which, in the haste of the Report of the Secretary, we were able to extract for the information of our readers.

From the New York Herald of 10th December. ONE DAY LATER FROM CHINA.

The ship "Nantico" Captain She rings only one day later. We give below all the news. It is seen that nothing very extraordinary, occurred after the sailing of the "Globe."

The principal intelligence is the detention of the ships "Adelaide," "Stubs," and "Washington," Benson, at the Bacoa At- tiris, by the blockading force, then under Captain Warren, of the "Vintage." Application for their release being made by their agents to Captain Smith, then at Macao, he replied that "orders should be immediately given for them to proceed in charge of an officer to the Cap-syoon anchorage, where their case would be promptly investigated."

A letter was written prior to the 29th, in which the ship was laden with proof thereof under the Consular Seal, it is presumed that they will not have been long under detention.

The Resident at Anjer reported to us that accounts had been received at Batavia from Singapore to the middle of August, and that news of the failure of negotiations by Admiral Elliot had reached that port from China, and that hostilities had commenced on the coast, between the British forces, and the Chinese.

Ship Akbar, Dunbar, arrived at Singapore, from Macao, July 3d, in 20 days from that place, had transhipped her cargo to British vessels at Rho, and proceeded on the 21st July to Calcutta.

American bark Lintin, Townsend, arrived at Singapore on the 27th July, and proceeded also to Rho to tranship her cargo for England.
