KING CONSTANTINE.

Greek Ruler May Defy Country's War Party.



GREECE TO REMAIN NEUTRAL

King Constantine Prefers to Risk Revolution at Home.

LONDON, Nov. 7.—King Constantine of Greece has risked revolution to avoid going to war. Premier Zaimis, head of the Greek "neutrality cabinet," is to remain in office, a dispatch from Athens stated. Parliament will be dissolved at once, the message adds.

Zaimis will try to reconstruct his ministry. Its old members will be retained, the Athens message stated, but two new ones will be added.

It is taken for granted that these will be representatives of the war party. Probably one of them will be ex-Premier Venizelos, the party's leader, if he can be persuaded to accept.

KITCHENER GOES TO THE NEAR EAST

LONDON, Nov. 8.—Field Marshal Earl Kitchener, British secretary of state for war and the leading military figure in Great Britain, is on his way to the scene of the fighting in the near East, where it is expected he will delve deeply into conditions and adopt measures by which it is hoped in the entente capitals the situation may be worked out of the tangle in which it appears to be involved at present. The following official statement was made:

"Earl Kitchener, at the request of his colleagues, has left England for a short visit to the eastern theater of war."

It is not too much to say that this brief announcement has left Great Britain breathless. For twenty years Kitchener has been England's "save the day" fighting man.

It was Kitchener who was sent to smash the Mahdi and who battered his way through in the Khartoum expedition and it was Kitchener who by sheer force of killing turned the tide in the Boer war.

JOSE OROZCO CONFESSES

Prisoner at El Paso Tells of Plot to Invade Mexico.

SAN ANTONIO, Tex., Nov. 7.—Jose Orozco, former chief for his cousin, General Pascual Orozco, and who is a prisoner at El Paso, has made a confession of the alleged plot to restore Victoriano Huerta to power in Mexico, according to information given out at the office of United States District Attorney J. L. Camp in San Antonio. It is understood warrants will be issued for at least twelve men said to be implicated in the plot.

Orozco, it is alleged, detailed the story of alleged plans for an uprising with ramifications in half a dozen states and for which agents in New York, New Orleans, Galveston and San Antonio were working.

KENTUCKY RESULT IN DOUBT

Both Parties Still Claim Election of Governor.

LOUISVILLE, Ky., Nov. 6.—Unofficial but apparently reliable tabulation of the gubernatorial vote in Kentucky gave A. O. Stanley, Democrat, an indicated majority of 2,081 over Edwin P. Morrow, Republican. Republican state campaign headquarters issued its first official statement. It claimed Mr. Morrow had been elected by 1,476 votes.


