THE CONVENTION TAX

TO COLLECTORS AND SHERIFFS.

Further Extension of Time for Settling with the Auditor.

BOARD OF REGISTRATION, New Orleans, April 29, 1898.

At a regular meeting of the Board, held on Wednesday, April 29, 1898, the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the time for the final settlement of the Convention taxes by the Tax Collectors and Sheriffs throughout the State is hereby extended to the first day of June, 1898.

By virtue of the foregoing resolution, I hereby notify all Tax Collectors and Sheriffs throughout the State to continue to collect the Convention tax up to the first day of June, 1898.

The Tax Collectors and Sheriffs are further instructed that they will be held responsible for a strict enforcement of the ordinance adopted by the Convention January 1, 1898 (which is hereinafter published for the information of all concerned), exacting a penalty for non-payment of said tax.

The Convention remitted all penalties up to the twentieth day of March, 1898, and from that time the penalty will be exacted on the date, and thirty days after the date, when the tax is due.

RESOLUTION.

Section 1. The Convention of the Constitutional Convention of the State of Louisiana, 1897-1898, and the sheriffs and tax collectors of the State, except of the city of New Orleans, shall give notice to the taxpayers of their respective parishes to pay the tax of one mill per cent, levied by the Convention, on the twenty-fourth day of March, 1898, by this Convention; and thirty days after service of said notice, those who shall not have paid the tax due by them shall be considered as delinquent, and the sheriffs and tax collectors shall exact an additional tax from such persons of twenty-five per cent on the sum due by them for the tax on the first day of June, 1898, and the original tax to be computed on the original tax for every subsequent thirty days said persons shall continue to be in default, until the tax is paid in full.

Sec. 2. Be it further ordained, That the sheriffs and tax collectors of the city of New Orleans, Orleans right bank, and parish of Jefferson, shall by public notice in one newspaper published in their parish call upon all taxpayers to pay the tax levied by the ordinance of December 24 above mentioned, and all persons who shall not have paid the amounts due by them on account of said tax ten days after the publication of the above required notice shall pay an additional tax of twenty-five per cent on the original tax, and an additional tax of two and a half per cent on the original tax of ten days after the publication of the above required notice shall continue to be in default.

Sec. 3. Be it further ordained, That immediately after the expiration of the thirty or ten days, as the case may be, given in the notice required by the first and second sections of this ordinance, the sheriffs and tax collectors throughout the State shall proceed to seize and sell after ten days notice property of the delinquent taxpayers, movable and immovable, sufficient to pay the original tax, all additional taxes herein levied, and costs.

Adopted in Convention at the city of New Orleans, on the fourth day of January, 1898, by a majority of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight.
