The action of General Buchanan in postponing the meeting of the Legislature until November next, if carried out, will work such serious damage to the city as to call for your attention to the subject of the city finances.

IT PASSES THE HOUSE BY A LARGE MAJORITY.

Severe Penalties for Obstructing Organization.

WASHINGTON, June 9, 1868.

The House to-day passed, by a vote of one hundred and fifteen to thirty-one, a bill reported by the committee on reconstruction providing for the immediate inauguration of State officers and convening the Legislatures of the Southern States as provided for in their constitutions respectively.

The bill makes it a felony punishable with five years imprisonment for any military or civil officer to prevent the meeting of the Legislature or the installation of State officers. The bill will no doubt pass the Senate at once.
