WASHINGTON.

\$375,000 Internal Revenue Receipts.—House's Argument in Favor of Repealing Legal Tender Decision—featuring the Texas Members.—The Senate on Ames Case—Sparking Debate on the Congress—Congress on Butler—Cannon's Unparliamentary Language.

WASHINGTON, March 31.—Internal revenue receipts to-day, \$375,000. The President and several cabinet members, the Cabinet will attend General Thomas' funeral.

The national bank convention made further arguments against the funding bill, but the House and Means Committee, Secretary Boutwell was present during the arguments. A mass of evidence was presented tending to show that the banks could not operate profitably on 4 per cent loans.

Mr. Carlisle was opposed to bringing up this question, and said they had nothing to do in majorities, and that this trouble would be done from their reviews.

House.—After a long argument, the bill transferring the property of the Freedmen's Bureau to the Education Bureau, and the acceptance of the amendment that the money be expended under the direction of the President of the United States.

NEW YORK. Money Market Active—Failure of Petroleum Merchants—Gold Weak—Five Millions Public Debt Decrease—Southern Securities Lower.

New York, March 31.—The money market was more active at the close. Call loans 5 1/2. Snow & Burgess, petroleum merchants, are reported as having suspended. S. A. New York is tight. It looks as if it will continue down some distance. The value per ton is \$135.

Foreign exchange is very weak, under light demand for a full supply of Southern bills and of bills made against securities; prime \$1 1/2.

Gold weak in sympathy with vague rumors that the Secretary of the Treasury made a favorable impression on the Congress and Ways and Means in behalf of the funding bill, with weakness in foreign exchange, and a further increase of specie in the hands of England and France.

Deposits also further that the public debt statement for March will show a decrease of five millions. Prices opened at 1 1/2, and closed at 1 1/4. Clearings were \$45,000,000. Governments: Old
