THE SCHOOL EXAMINATION.

Mr. Superintendent Carter was again early in the field yesterday, beginning his visit with the Jackson Boys' School.

Here, we found in the basement of the church, at the corner of Howard and Cyrene streets, a school of the boys.

There are usually from 450 to 500 pupils in attendance, but at this time there are only 120.

In the principal's room we heard a lengthy but interesting review in grammar, which showed that the boys had devoted some attention to this useful branch of education.

Mr. Gordon has had charge since the first of March merely, during which time he has taught his boys out in a manner quite flattering to his skill and attention to his duties.

Mrs. E. C. Fisher, is also a very superior teacher, and has a class of well grown and fairly advanced boys under tuition.

A short examination by the Superintendent showed that they were familiar with their studies. In the other departments we found neatly attired little fellows, all or nearly all of whom were ready and anxious to respond to any duty required of them by their teachers or Mr. Carter.

The teachers on the other hand, were all named, are Miss H. Dolan, who has been one of the assistants in the Jackson Boys' School for six or seven years.
