A PROCLAMATION by the President of the United States.

WHEREAS a convention defining the rights, immunities and privileges of consuls, between the United States of America and His Majesty the King of the Belgians...

ARTICLE I. Each of the high contracting parties agrees to receive from the other, consular agents...
