OF CARONDELET STREET. In comparison with the lamplitude of the last two weeks, yesterday was a field day in Carondelet street. Something like the animation of the flush times of other days was displayed, and the countenances of brokers, plethoric with orders, showed the influence of the occasion. The centre of attraction was the "Lightning Stock" or Slaughterhouse, and in this the transactions were very heavy. The first heavy operation was a purchase of 500 shares, in one lot, at 25, by a leading Carondelet street house. This was followed by others at the same figure, and when the day closed the house had managed to secure 1480 shares at prices ranging from 24 1/2 to 25. Another well-known broker purchased nearly a thousand shares, and the other sales brought the total up to about 3000 shares. The principal portion of this was bought at 25, and the operation must have been extremely well managed not to have moved the market more than a quarter of a point. Many persons were expecting a more sudden and more rapid rise, basing their anticipations on the arrival of the president of the company, whose presence always seems to have a very appreciable influence on this stock. If he has come into the market already, his movements must have been carefully veiled from the public eye.

Almost the entire interest of the street was absorbed yesterday. Slaughterhouse and other stocks were treated with a cold, and almost cruel indifference. There was some discussion, however, concerning the election for Directors of the Mississippi Valley Navigation Company. An excellent ticket was chosen, and it is worthy of remark that over 800,000 votes were cast, thus showing that the stockholders take a general and lively interest in the affairs of the company. An amendment to the charter was adopted, authorizing an assessment of one dollar a share on the stock. This will be made payable in four installments, commencing on the fifteenth of January next.

At night there were some indications of an improvement in Calcasieu Sulphur stock, based, probably, on the anticipation of a favorable decision of the case now pending in Judge Thoard's court. The decision will probably be rendered in a few days.

Barbair's stock seems to be growing weaker. It is no longer the sensation of the day, and holders have considerably abated their pretensions. Five shares were sold yesterday at \$120; a falling off, in about four weeks, of \$130 a share. This is almost as remarkable as the unprecedented rise of the stock during the months of October and November.

There was some business done at the board last night, and the monotony of offers and bids, without result, was varied by several sales. The sales were as follows: 100 shares Slaughterhouse at 25; 25 shares Calcasieu preferred at 27; 200 shares Canal Bank at 41; \$10,000 gold at 110; Jefferson City bonds (\$1000) at 80; \$2100 City seven at 69; and Bank of New Orleans certificates at 82. The last mentioned sale was afterward canceled.
