Indiscriminate firing ensued. Two colored persons were killed by the shot. Tyler jumped from the second story to the ground, pursued by the Sheriff and posse, and was shot to death. The citizens assembled in large numbers, armed to assist the Sheriff. A difficulty occurred between John Long and George Harmon, in which Long was stabbed in a number of places. His wounds are considered dangerous.
