**PROPERTY IN POLICE HANDS.**—When prisoners are taken into the Second Police station the turnkeys search each one, as has been customary for many years. This action is necessary principally to secure any weapons the accused may have about his person. It is usual to take all valuables also, in order that the man may not be robbed when in a cell. The articles taken are made into a bundle and labeled, and in the morning sent up to the Recorder, at least in the habit in most instances. To this extent of red tape works a hardship on the prisoners, for they seldom obtain their goods until an escape of hours, after waiting until clerks or officers find a convenient time to wait on them. It frequently occurs that unfortunate lose a day's work by these delays. It is hoped that where these deficiencies exist a reformation will take place; for all who are arrested are not criminals, and an innocent party ought not to be compelled to lose time. This subject requires official attention, that a remedy may be applied. When property is sent to Captain Curtis, metropolitan property clerk, claimants find no difficulty in securing their property, as his system is quite perfect. It is not meant that the recorder's clerks or officers are to be blamed; it is simply to change a poor custom.
