WASHINGTON, April 13.—Congress, at its last session, passed an act to reimburse the State of Kansas for moneys expended in equipping, equipping and provisioning the militia forces to aid in suppressing the rebellion. Under the authority of this act the Secretary of War appointed Inspector General Hardie, Major Bingham, and Paymaster Stanton to proceed to Fort Leavenworth and examine the items of expenditure, and ascertain the balance against the United States.
