The Alleged Coalition-Wilkes' History.

New York, December 18.—George Wilkes publishes a history of the alleged coalition between the Southern States and the Democracy. The opposition to Grant is to be based on the term plank. Wilkes says he saw many prominent Republicans, especially editors, and that they were in favor of it. He then adds the question being asked by the Republican leaders, as if any limited number of leaders can direct the general action of a party, it became proper that the chiefs of the Democratic party, whose just hostility to Grant would necessarily co-operate in any measure united to depose him, should be frankly informed of the course which the reform Republicans intended to take. I went to Washington on Monday last, and put myself in communication with some of the principal Democratic members of both houses. The first result was a meeting at my rooms at the Arlington, on Tuesday evening, of a large number of the most prominent Democratic members of the House and Senate. I was the sole Republican present, and I opened the subject of the occasion by stating that my purpose in desiring to see them, was to communicate to them the substance of the views of prominent members of the next Presidential election. It was not my object to seek an expression of their views upon that subject, but to project a coalition, but simply to lay before them in frank, good faith the course which the gentlemen with whom I was associated intended to pursue in the coming campaign. I stated that the spontaneous action which would follow on their part would be better than any compact which could be formed. That, in fact, anything in the shape of a compact or coalition would, in my opinion, be a failure, and not by any means promote the object to be gained. I then recited what has been detailed before, along with the substance of the conclusions which would be premature if given now. I next submitted the preamble and resolution which have been given above. Some discussion and consultation ensued, in which my views seemed to be approved. My opinions were then asked upon several points, to which I replied that I felt great interest in the policy of the Democratic party to gentlemen so experienced as those present, but now that they had given me the privilege of expressing myself in that way, I would ask that they be in mind that the logical candidate for the Republican nomination to adopt would be one who would not likely be most unwelcome to the Democrats, and who would be likely to select a candidate partially agreeable to the Democracy, or to yield them the Vice President on a fusion ticket, would prevent the Democratic party from being forced, and leave the immense flood of the Republican majority to roll back and settle at the feet of Grant.

All these views seemed to be approvingly received, and the gentlemen who attended went in, but at the same time, with an intelligent understanding which will probably have more binding force than any treaty that could have been made. I may add that it is very probable that the Democratic party will hold a convention of some sort between now and February, in which it will enunciate the one term principle along with the Reform Republicans, who will soon be ready to endorse it. All the while during this course, the Democracy will bear an attitude of austere observation operating mainly as an armed reserve, free from all coalitions, but prepared to act with wisdom and vigor.

Escaped from Jail. The Morehouse Conservative reports the escape from the jail in that parish, one evening lately, of one Gorham, charged with the murder of J. B. Alexander. Sheriff Phelps relates the manner of escape. He says: He had exercised great care in keeping his prisoners locked up in their cells, letting them out only at meal time. Believing that escape was impossible under such circumstances—the present inside the jail, and a guard on duty, he had not hesitated to grant them the liberty of the jail room at such times. On the day of Gorham's escape he had, as usual, allowed this liberty. He (the sheriff) had commenced closing the cell doors, and was about to go down when Gorham approached the door from the opposite side of the cells, and giving the usual signal, the outer guard opened the door, and Gorham rushed out by him. The sheriff further states that hereafter prisoners in his charge shall not have the liberty of the jail room at meal hours, nor any other time.

The Opelousas says: Mr. Joseph Fabacher, of the German settlement at Opelousas, called on us this morning and reports the settlement in a prosperous condition. He says the crops are good, and the potatoes—both Irish and sweet—grown by him this season are unsurpassed. He planted some Irish potatoes on the twenty-eighth of last September and did not water them until just two months and four days after planting. He showed us some of those dug, which were as large and larger than a man's fist. They were the largest of home grown potatoes we have seen this year.

The Alexandria Democrat indulges in melancholy fancies about the crops, and says: We have well posted ourselves, during the past few days, concerning the final result of the cotton and corn crop of Louisiana, and now have no hesitation in asserting that the failure is almost an entire one, by far the most complete and disastrous ever known. We will sum it up: Corn, a total failure; cotton, a very small crop; and sugar, barely an average fourth. This is indeed a sad picture, but the plain, unvarnished truth, and must be proclaimed and not hid. We have not the heart to say any more, for the present, of such a terrible calamity.

It is stated that the young cadet at West Point who was the subject of having been caused the expulsion of two cadets, was one Devine, appointed by Representative Orr, of Iowa. Devine would not have been expelled, had he not been charged with an attempt to seduce a female cadet.
