MESSAGES FROM THE HOUSE.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, Office of Chief Clerk, New Orleans, January 27, 1872.

To the Honorable President and Members of the Senate:

I am directed to ask the concurrence of the Senate in the following bills:

House bill No. 300, an act authorizing Darius Hebert and Pauline Hebert, of the parish of Caldwell, to adopt Narcissus Gertrude Hebert.

House bill No. 299, an act authorizing Irvin A. Meredith and Achab E. Meredith, of the parish of Caldwell, to adopt Mary A. Humble.

House bill No. 292, joint resolution relative to the suspension from office of N. A. Robinson, of the Ninth Judicial District Court, by executive order.

House bill No. 291, joint resolution appointing a special committee of the House and Senate to prepare an address to the Congress of the United States upon the subject of the existing revolutionary crisis in the State of Louisiana.

Also, to inform the Senate that the House has concurred in Senate bill No. 277, an act to be entitled an act to incorporate the City of Carrollton, approved March 17, 1859, and acts supplementary thereto.

MESSAGES TO THE HOUSE.

The Secretary asked the concurrence of the House in substitute for Senate bill No. 261, to be entitled an act defining the distances from the domicile of members of the General Assembly to the State House, fixing the mode of ascertaining the per diem of members of the General Assembly for the time engaged in going to and returning from the State House, and the mileage to be paid, and the number of employees of the General Assembly, and their compensation, and defining their duties, and making an appropriation to defray the expenses of the General Assembly.

Also informed the House that the Senate had indefinitely postponed the following House bills of the following bills:

House bill No. 239, to be entitled an act to authorize the police jury of the parish of Morehouse to issue the bonds of the parish to the amount not exceeding \$50,000.

House bill No. 72, to be entitled an act for the relief of Clark H. Remick, tax collector in and for the parish of Vermilion.

House bill No. 153, to be entitled an act to repeal an act entitled "An act to establish a Board of Public Works for the State of Louisiana, and to define the duties of the same," approved September 8, 1868.

Mr. Anderson rose to a question of privilege, relative to an article appearing in yesterday's edition of the National Republican, and requested that the Committee on Finance be instructed to make a thorough investigation into the legality of the certificates of indebtedness therein referred to.

Mr. Campbell moved that the Finance Committee be so instructed.

Mr. Ray raised the point of order that the motion of Mr. Campbell was out of order.

The President decided the point not well taken.

Mr. Ingraham offered the following as a substitute for Mr. Campbell's motion:

Resolved, That a committee of three members of the Senate be appointed by the President of the Senate for the purpose of investigating the action of the board of liquidators constituted under the second section of act No. 69 of the extra session of 1870, and of the first section of the act amendatory thereto, No. 43, of 1861, and particularly to ascertain whether said board of liquidators under said acts paid any claims against the State not authorized by said acts, or which had not been sanctioned by law, or the payment of which was prohibited by the constitution, and to ascertain to whom any such claims have been paid, and who was the owner of the claim at the time of payment, and any other information which may be serviceable to the State; and that said committee be and are hereby authorized to send for any and all vouchers, books, papers, or other evidence necessary for their investigation, and for all persons and witnesses they may deem necessary, and to report by bill or otherwise.

Mr. Hunsaker moved to refer the subject matter to the Committee on Judiciary, which was adopted, on a call of the yeas and nays, by the following vote:
