CITY COUNCIL—OFFICIAL

REGULAR MEETING.

CITY HALL, NEW ORLEANS, Tuesday, June 11, 1872.

The Council met in regular session at noon.

Present—Mayor Benj. F. Bondano in the chair, and Administrators H. Bonzano (Assessments), John S. Walton (Finance), James Lewis (Police), F. C. Remick (Commerce), L. T. Delassie (Waterworks and Public Buildings), Alfred Shaw (Public Accounts), and John Cochran (Improvements).

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved without reading.

Veto Withdrawals.

The Mayor, on the certificate of the Surveyor that the work had since been completed satisfactorily, withdrew his veto as regards the repairs to the engine houses and the repairs of several other engine houses for further consideration; and also withdrew his veto of the repairs of Orleans Engine house No. 21, made by Sorblet, the Surveyor having examined the work and certified that it was done in accordance with specifications.
