REGULAR MEETING.

CITY HALL, NEW ORLEANS, Tuesday, October 25, 1872. The Council was called to order in regular session at 12 M.

Present—Mayor Benj. F. Flanders (presiding), and Administrators John Cookren (Improvements), Alfred Shaw (Public Accounts), L. T. Delasalle (Waterworks and Public Buildings), F. C. Remick (Commerce), James Lewis (Police), John S. Walton (Finance), and H. Bonzano (Assessments).

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved and their reading dispensed with.

Financial Business.

Mr. Shaw called up the ordinance read twice and entered in the proceedings of the last meeting, providing for the expenses of the Department of Police, commencing John W. Madden \$25.

Adopted.

Mr. Bonzano announced that a number of gentlemen were present who were anxious to state their views to the Administration relative to the proposed loan from the Fiscal Agent. He moved that the Council take a recess, subject to the call of the Chair.

It was so ordered.

At 4:15 P. M. the Mayor again called the Council to order.

Mr. Shaw called up the miscellaneous cash ordinance, read twice and printed last week, commencing New Orleans Republican \$1714 10.
